- Ami dadle. [We are men.]
(baylô [women], chøle/čhedde/bhurge [boys], chøliyô/čheddvam [girls], Bhurgim [children], mønīs [human beings], xikpi [students], xikôvpi [teachers], dotor [doctor], nõvre [bridegrooms], høklo [bride])
- Tem čheddum. [She is a girl.]
(bhurgem, ghør [house], mez [table], kellem [banana], tantim [egg], tarum [ship], pôrsum [garden])
- Tim čheddvam. [They are girls.]
(Bhurgim, ghøram, mezam, kêllim, tantyam, tarvam, porsam).
