

Pronouns: 2**Pronoun Meaning**

Kitem what

Konn who

Ho [m] this

Hi [f] this

Hem [nt] this

Take note: “Kitem” is used to ask questions related to things and non-human beings.

“Konn” is used to ask questions related to human beings.

Exercise:

1. Hem kitem? [What is this?]
 - Ho reddo. [This is a he-buffalo.]
 - He redde. [These are he-buffaloes.]
 - Hi gay. [This is a cow.]
 - Hyô gayô. [These are cows.]
 - Hem pustøk. [This is a book.]
 - Him pustøkam. [These are books.]

2. Ho konn? [Who is this?]
 - Ho mÿzo ixtt. [This is my male friend.]
 - He konn? [Who are these?]
 - He mÿje ixtt. [These are my male friends.]
 - Hi konn? [Who is this?]
 - Hi mÿji ixttinn. [This is my female friend.]
 - Hyô konn? [Who are these?]
 - Hyô mÿjyô ixttinni. [These are my female friends.]
 - Hem Konn? [Who is this?]
 - Hem Rita. [This is Rita.]
 - Him konn? [Who are these?]
 - Him mÿjim ixttam. [These are my male and female friends.]
